



# 15th Nippon Jamboree – 2010

## Scout Association of Japan

(as of 3 September 2009)

**Dates:** Monday, 2 August to Sunday, 8 August 2010  
**Camp in:** Sunday, 1 August  
**Camp out:** Monday, 9 August

**Theme:** "Take Wing to the World!"  
This theme embodies our earnest desire for Scouts to soar higher by developing a broad perspective and lofty aspirations while experiencing harmony with nature at Asagiri Plateau, which offers inspiring views of Mt. Fuji, together with young people from throughout Japan and around the world.

**Venue:** Asagiri Plateau  
Fujinomiya City, Shizuoka prefecture Hilly location at the western foot of Mt. Fuji  
Latitude: 35.23 north Longitude: 138.35 east  
Altitude: 800 - 860m (0.49-0.53 mile)  
Geology: The site consists mostly of grassland and is firm and well drained.

### Climate at the Jamboree

The summer climate around Jamboree site is regarded as cool and comfortable, though the weather often changes. Fog can cover the plateau quickly, and this gave rise to the name of Asagiri, which means "foggy morning." Average temperature at the Jamboree site on August in the past 5 years has been 21.8degC (71.2degF), the minimum 19.7degC (67.4degF) and the maximum 24.5degC (76.1degF).

**Participants:** The Jamboree participants will be as follows:

Scouts (age 12-18 on 1 August 2010 – that is those born between 2 August 1991 and 1 August 1998)  
Leaders (age 19 and over)  
IST (age 19 and over)

The standard troop size will be 36 Scouts and 4 adult leaders. The troop should be organized into 4 patrols of 9 young people. Contingents not having enough patrols to form a complete troop will be requested to join with other patrols, from Japan or other countries, to form a troop.

Scouts/Guides and leaders from overseas must be registered as members of their own National Scout/Guide Organizations and their application must be approved by their National Scout/Guide Organization. (If your contingent would like to send Contingent staff who will support your Contingent leader, please do not hesitate to ask us.)

**Camp Fee:** The Jamboree Fee will be as follows: (All fees are charged in Japanese Yen.)

JPY40,000- per person, for Scouts/Guides and leaders including Contingent leader, Troop leader and IST  
(IST fee for youth aged 19-25 on 1 August 2010, born between 2 August 1984 and 1 August 1991, is JPY33,000- per person, as a benefit of discount).

The fee includes the following:

- Jamboree Participation kit including badge and ID
- All the program fees during the Jamboree
- Meals for the duration of the Jamboree, for 23 meals from dinner on 1 August. (Meals for IST will be 30 meals from dinner on 30 July.)

Other expenses are the responsibilities of participating overseas contingents. For example, the following fees are of your own expenses:

- Personal equipment such as personal catering kit (knives, forks, mug and plate) and sleeping bag.
- Cost of touring in Japan, such as transportation from International Airport of your arrival to the Jamboree site, and from the Jamboree site to the ports of departure.
- Camping equipment (tents, tables, etc.)

Please note that troop camping equipment including tents and tables will be available for hire or buy. Detailed information will be informed when it becomes available.
